Fun treats you can make for your dog

1. Peanut Butter Oat Balls—ingredients, 1 cup rolled oats, $\frac{1}{2}$ cup peanut butter, $\frac{1}{4}$ plain yogurt
2. Banana Pumpkin Bites- ingredients, $\frac{1}{2}$ mashed banana, $\frac{1}{2}$ cup canned plain pumpkin, 1 cup oats
3. Frozen Yogurt Bites- ingredients, 1 cup plain yogurt, handful blueberries & strawberries
4. Sweet Potato Mash Bites-ingredients, 1cup cooked mashed sweet potato, 1 cup oats

Fun brain games you can do with your dog

1. Pea Game- put peas in a bowl with water and let them try to get the peas
2. Muffin Tin Puzzle- place treats in a muffin tin and cover holes with tennis balls
3. Cup Shuffle Game- use three cups, hide a treat under one, shuffle them and let your dog pick a cup
4. Hide and Seek- have your dog stay, you hide and then call their name
5. Towel Roll-Up Puzzle- roll a towel flat, put treats in it and then roll it up tightly
6. Digging Box- get a box put towels or paper towels in it and hide treats in it
7. Stack Cups- stack some cups, hide a treat under one, find a way for your dog to knock them down
